**Greetings Everyone,**

**PROUT "Village in the Town":** This project is based on PROUT, a socio-economic philosophy given by Shri P. R. Sarkar. Amongst the PROUT Fundamental Principles we are focusing on the first one "Yugasya sarvanimna prayojanam' Sarves'a'm' vidheyam," which means the minimum requirement of life- food, clothes, shelter, education and medical care must be guaranteed to

every individual. After Planetary Leadership Training classes, I felt that it was necessary to also have a practical side to this training. This project is made to bridge the rural-urban gap with a sustainable economy. On one side, urban people will get fresh and local products at fair prices and on the other side, rural people will earn enough to pay for the minimum requirements of life.

### **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:**

1. To establish economic projects to help the villagers to become self-sufficient according to the principles of PROUT.
2. To support the villagers to obtain their minimum requirements (food, clothing, medicine, housing and education) with co-operative system and other programs.
3. To create spiritually minded social workers.
4. To run an educational coaching centre for the local population.
5. To run regular medical camps for local people by expert doctors.
6. To develop agriculture for self-sufficiency.

### **PROGRAMES IN ACTION:**

1. Educational and computer classes have started for needy and poor children. Now we have 16 students. All of them play an active role in different awareness programs organised by this centre.



2. Parivartan Women Self Help Group is registered under the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India. We have 13 members in our group. Our women members have started producing masks during the pandemic. They have distributed free masks in different parts of the city and appealed to people to join hands in the fight against the wave of Coronavirus. School uniforms and other stitched cloths are made by them according to the demand of the local market, give them an independent income.



3. Cultivation of Tulsi-herbal plants started with two farmers on two acres of land. Now more farmers are ready to join us in the next cultivation period with other herbal plants.



4. We are also growing organic vegetables on ten acres, with other farmers. More farmers are joining this production team as we are giving them guarantee with buy back agreement.



5. Processing site based on solar energy is under construction. We are using solar energy to irrigate organic vegetables and other herbal plants. Many villagers have shown interest and few have given order for solar panels too. With the help of ANDS (Anand Nagar Development Society), we are promoting the use of solar panels to villagers.
